Star Swimmers

The women's swim team competed in the 2007 AWCC Championships hosted by Chatham College in Pittsburgh, Pa. on Feb. 3-4. The Express finished fifth with 48 points.

Erica Thomas '08 highlighted the weekend's results for The Express earning second team all-conference honors with two second-place finishes in freestyle events. In the 100 freestyle finals, Thomas was just 1.2 seconds shy of the win with a time of 1:00.03. In the 500 freestyle, Thomas was seeded sixth in the race but recorded a season-best time of 6:00.10 to claim second. She also placed fourth in both the 200 freestyle and 200 breaststroke events.

Colleen Keegan '10 earned an eighth-place finish in the 1000 freestyle with a time of 13:54.90 and a 10th-place time of 6:48.38 in the 500 freestyle. She also placed 14th in the 200 free and 15th in the 100 free on the weekend.

Kelsey Stafford '10 and Breanna Roland '10 finished right behind Keegan in both the 100 and 200 freestyle events. Stafford was 15th in the 200 free and 17th in the 100 free, while Roland took the 16th spot in both events. Stafford also claimed 10th in the 1000 freestyle and 12th in the 500 free. Roland completed the 200 and 100 butterfly in 12th and 13th place, respectively.

Katya Zavala '09 placed 11th for the Express in the 100 breaststroke and 15th in the 200 individual medley, while Sierra

Stiller-Saiger '10 finished right behind Zavala in the 100 breaststroke and also took 13th in the 200 breaststroke.

The men's swim team completed the 2007 season with a solid showing at the Upper New York State Collegiate Swimming Association Championships in Syracuse on Feb. 22-24. The Express finished 14th in the state with 26 points.

Court Carnahan '10 earned new College records in the 50 freestyle and the 100 butterfly, while Chris Van Wert '08 earned College bests in the 100 and 200

freestyles. Carnahan, Van Wert along with teammates Brandon Doughty '10 and Nate Kelsey also set Wells College records in the 200 freestyle relay and the 200-medley relay at the meet.

2007-08 Tuition

At its February meeting, the Board of Trustees set next year's tuition at \$16,510; room and board will be \$8,100 and fees \$1,300. The total price of a Wells education for the 2007-08 academic year will be \$25,910 — an overall increase of only 5.4 percent.
