Andrew Zepp is executive director of the *Finger Lakes Land Trust*, an Ithaca-based non-profit conservation organization that works cooperatively with landowners and local communities to permanently protect undeveloped lands that are important to the character of the Finger Lakes Region. The Land Trust was established in 1989 through Cornell's Department of Natural Resources. Since then, the group has secured more than 19,000 acres of the region's remaining pristine lakeshore, rugged gorges, majestic forest, and scenic farmland.
