Sustainability in Practice: The DEC's Approach to Managing New York State's Waters

Anthony Prestigiacom, research scientist for the *Finger Lakes Water Hub*, will introduce his organization and provide an overview of basic limnology (lake science) concepts, with examples from the Finger Lakes. He will outline the DEC's processes for managing lakes and streams, and monitoring and assessing water bodies in NYS. He will explain how the State prioritizes, plans, and implements clean water initiatives to protect or rehabilitate impaired or threatened water bodies, and offer examples of rehabilitation successes as well as ongoing efforts in the Finger Lakes.
