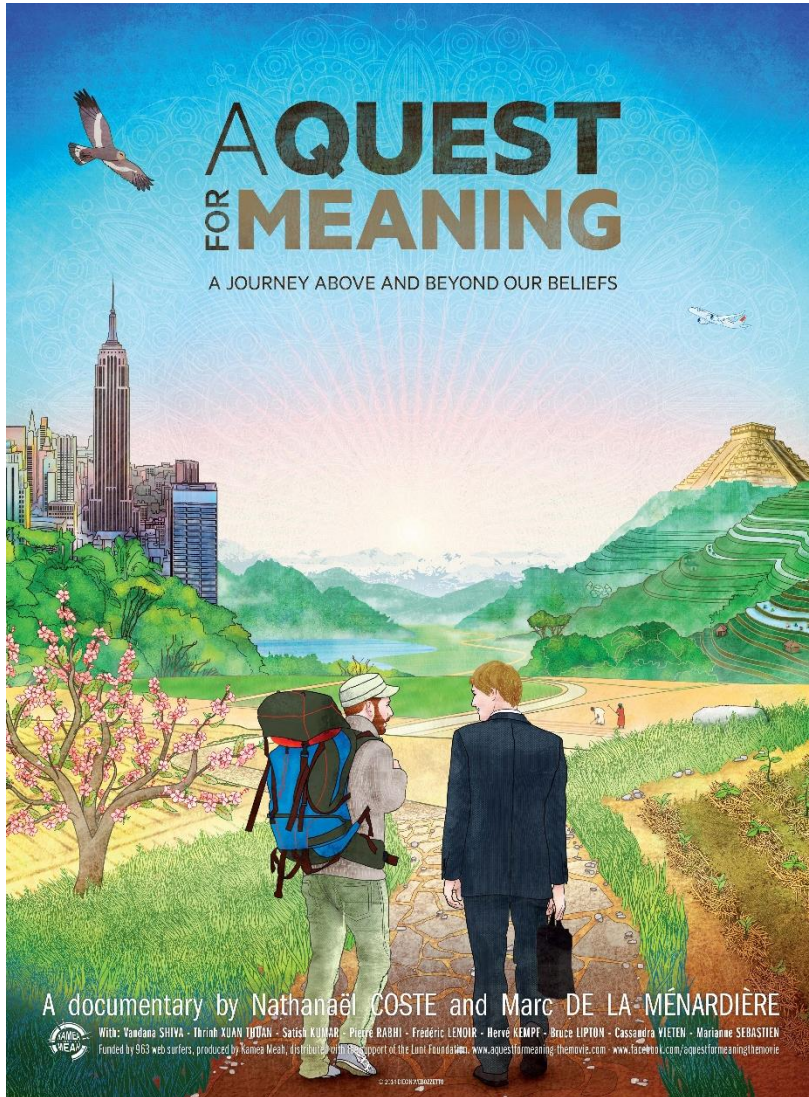


Sustainability Film Series
