




Global CO2 Emissions by Income Group






Human supremacy is a worldview that esteems the human as a distinguished entity that is superior to all other life forms and is entitled to use them and the places they live.






Humans and The Extinction Crisis




The idea that parenthood and raising children should be the central focus of every person's adult life. It is a strong social force and includes a collection of beliefs so embedded that they have come to be seen as true





Pronatalism is especially disempowering for girls, because from a young age they're groomed for marriage and motherhood, and can never even come to think of motherhood as choice, and this robs them of their ability to fully live out their authentic selves.







If you're like us - mothers with an attitude problem - you may be getting increasingly irritable about this chasm between the ridiculous, honey-hued ideals of perfect motherhood in the mass. media and the reality of mothers' everyday lives.








African Diaspora women like myself who want to be independent of children are oftentimes not just seen as defying our womanhood, but defying our Blackness and defying our Africanness. People have explicitly said that we have fallen for the white people's scheme, we're killing out our people








The 'biological clock' that some women claim to hear ticking is also a 'social clock' reminding them that whatever else may be going on in their lives, motherhood is their destiny, the road to social acceptance and integration.









And even though ambivalence is a feeling that may accompany each and every one of our human relationships, there is only one answer society tolerates from mothers to the question of motherhood: "I love it."







For young women, especially for women who haven't had children, it's very hard to get a sterilization procedure, in large part, because of the assumption that every woman will want a child. Doctors have a serious reluctance to get in the middle of that. So, that's another aspect of reproductive rights that we don't even talk about—the right to get permanent contraception.


