We will keep an eye peeled for stuff to restock the shelves in the *RUMPUS Room* (office supplies) and the *Bargain Basement* (everything else) for incoming and returning students to avail themselves of in the fall.

PLEASE turn everything off...


If you will be out of your office for any extended period of time this summer, please make sure **to turn off and unplug** any
