

In compliance with the Missing Student Procedures (Section 488 of the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008), it is the policy of Wells College and the Department of Campus Safety to investigate any report of a missing student who resides in campus housing at Wells College.

Each student living in a campus student housing facility has the option to identify an individual to be contacted by the College and register confidential contact information in the event that the student is determined to be missing for a period of more than 24 hours. Only authorized campus officials and law enforcement officers in furtherance of a missing person investigation may have access to this information.

If the resident student is under 18 years of age, and not an emancipated individual, you must complete this compliance form with emergency contacts being a custodial parent or guardian.
