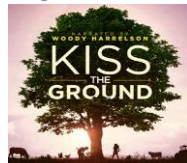

Watch Your Waste

In recent compost tote inspections, we noted too much contamination of non-compostable materials being dumped in the compost collection bin in the dining hall. A reminder: What goes in **compost**: All food waste (plate scrapings and other food scraps) as well as brown paper napkins.

What is **landfill trash**: anything else that is used once and then disposed of, including condiment cups, foil salad dressing packets, drink cartons, plastic butter "pods", plastic wrap, etc.
