Act 1: the conservation movement of the '60s, is narrated by **Robert Redford**.

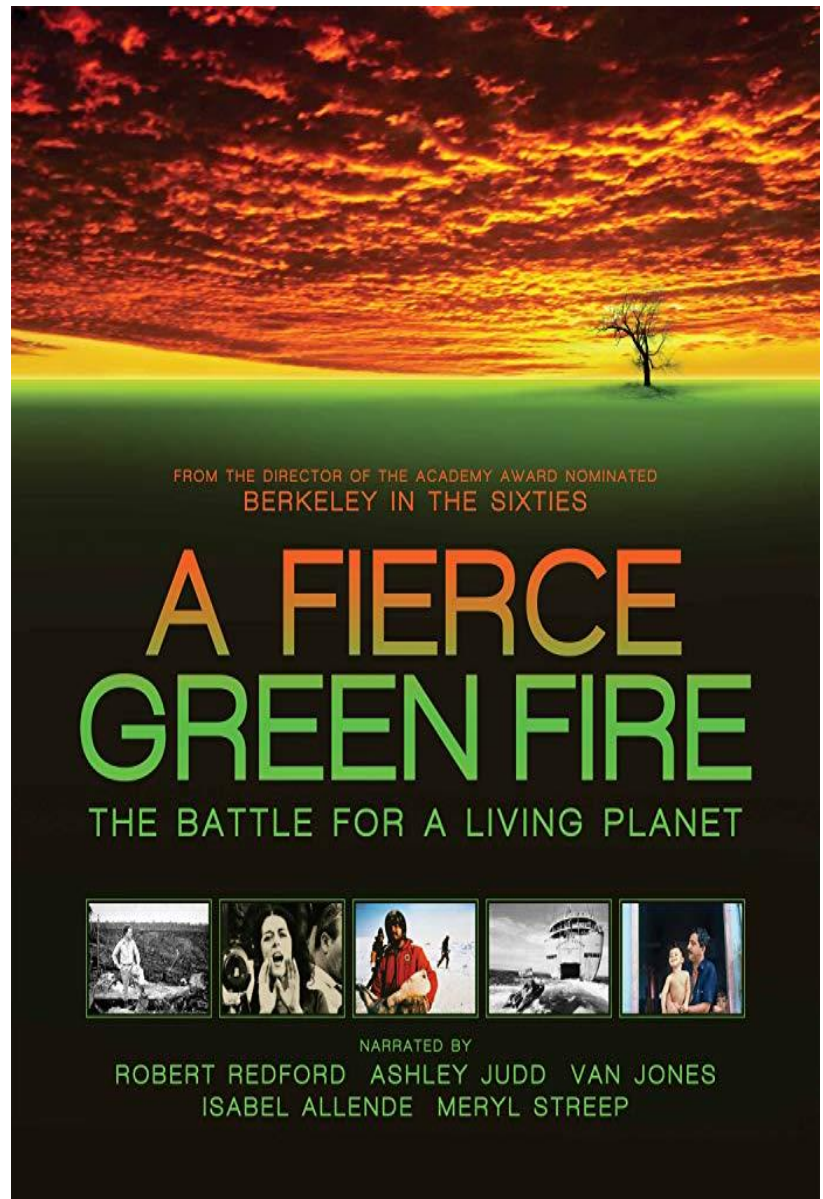
Act 2: the new environmental movement of the '70s, is narrated by **Ashley Judd**.
