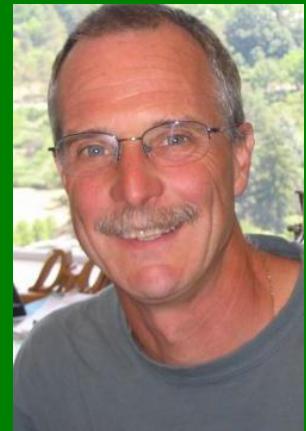




Sustainability Perspectives

Change is in the Air: Global Climate Change from a NY Perspective

Art DeGaetano, director of the *NOAA Northeast Regional Climate Center*, will use historical climate observations and climate model projections to show how global climate change is affecting New York and the Northeastern United States. Future projections rely heavily on simulations from climate models. To gain an appreciation for the accuracy of these model projections, an introduction to the Earth's climate system and the basic working of a modern climate model will be discussed.
