Knowledge, Perceptions, and Behaviors towards Sustainability: A Comparative Analysis

Srijana Bajracharya, professor and chair of Health Promotion and Physical Education at Ithaca College, will detail the results of her research study - conducted with a colleague from West Liberty University - to examine various characteristics and values as predictors of students' attitudes toward sustainability and related behaviors that support sustainability. The two institutions differ drastically in terms of their sustainability initiatives, so the study also sought to determine if one college's sustainability initiative played a role in changing student pro-environmental behaviors.
