

Taylor Reid is an Assistant Professor of Applied Food Studies at the Culinary Institute of America. He teaches courses in Food Systems Sustainability, Farm to Table, and Chef-Community Relations. His current research interests include the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the restaurant industry, chef's motivations for including foraged food on restaurant menus, and depictions of food insecurity and food procurement in the zombie genre.
